The new standard EN 1811:2011 has a narrower scope than the superseded standard. On 31 March 2013, the (partially) superseded standard ceases to apply with regards to the test methods for demonstrating compliance with the conditions of the restriction for the products that fall within the scope of the new standard.

CEN	EN 12472:2005 + A1:2009 Method for the simulation of wear and corrosion for the detection of nickel release from coated items	EN 12472:2005
CEN	EN 16128:2011 Reference test method for release of nickel from those parts of spectacle frames and sunglasses intended to come into close and prolonged contact with the skin	EN 1811:1998 + A1:2008

The new standard EN 16128:2011 takes over from the superseded standard the same test methods for demonstrating conformity with the conditions of the restriction under entry 27 of Annex XVII to REACH until a new standard for spectacle frames and sunglasses will be developed.
